2025 Membership Rules and Regulations

Thank you for becoming a member for the 2025 Golf Season. The following are some policies and rules that will benefit both you and the golf club to ensure “good operations”. Some benefits are; better course conditions, more tee-time availability etc.

Booking Policy

- Members can book tee times up to 14 days in advance by calling the proshop. The person who books the tee-time must name all players playing in the group.
- You may cancel the tee-time up to 24 hours in advance. If the tee time is not cancelled, the member will be charged for the number of players booked.
- The proshop reserves the right to move, modify or cancel tee times without notice.
- Single golfers can book tee times but may be moved without notice to pair with other golfers.

Golf Carts & Cart Paths

Safety first

- Golf Carts should only be operated from the driver’s side
- Never drive with more than two occupants or allow riders on the back of the cart.
- Be sure your passenger is fully seated and check for obstructions before moving.
- Keep your entire body - particularly your feet - inside the cart when moving.
- Drive slowly through turns and drive straight and slow up and down slopes.
- Use extra care when operating a golf cart in reverse, or on hills, wet turf, loose surfaces or rough terrain.

Course Rules and Etiquette

- Do not drive power carts beside greens and tees obeying all cart signs.
- All golfers must tee off starting on hole #1 unless instructed otherwise by the proshop
- Morning golfers must not play in less than 3 hours as it delays the course maintenance staff
- Replace all of your divots, repair ball marks and rake sand bunkers
- Fix at least 2-3 ball marks on every green
- Always be polite & courteous to fellow golfers and staff
